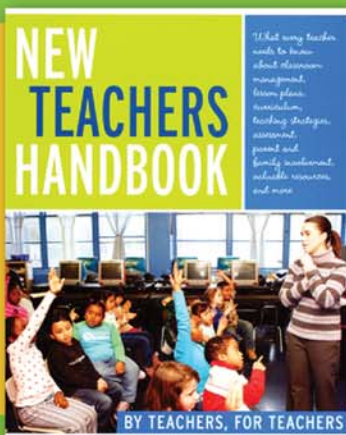

Receive our New Teachers Handbook—written by teachers, for teachers. The chapters correspond to the content in Balanced Literacy online courses.

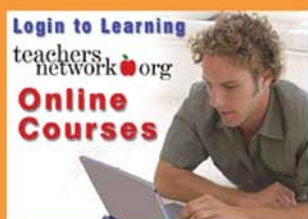
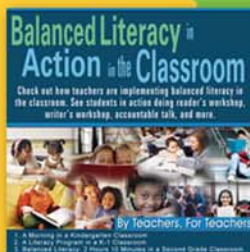
