Go for a 4!

When you have a long answer to do, there are certain things that the scorers will be looking for. To get a 4, you will need to complete the following 6 things:

1. Answer : Answer the question. If you can, turn around the question in your thesis
2. Parts: Make sure you answer all the parts of the question. You should check them off as you go
3. Details and Examples: Include as many specific details and examples from the text as you can
4. Focus: Stay focused on the question. Don't let your answer wander around. Have a main idea and details that support it. Make your pole house sturdy.
5. Sense + Sequence: Make sure every sentence makes sense, make sure the order of your sentences makes sense
6. Style: You should make your writing sound interesting. Personalize it. Include thoughts and opinions. Vary your sentence structure

"<u>A</u>lways <u>Perfect, <u>D</u>oing <u>Fine, Super <u>S</u>tudents"</u></u>

*In addition, when you go back and read over your piece, check it for PPCS: Paragraphs, Punctuation, Capitals, and Spelling.
