<b>Context Elements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Establishes time and place (setting) and point of view.</li> <li>✓ Identifies main character(s).</li> <li>✓ Clearly includes elements from my author's style.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Presents time and place in general terms.</li> <li>✓ Point of view is generally clear.</li> <li>✓ Presents character(s) using stereotypes, rather than "showing" characters.</li> <li>✓ Most elements reflect my author's style.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Presents a vague sense of time and place.</li> <li>✓ Point of view may not be constant or consistent.</li> <li>✓ Main character is generally identified by name and gender.</li> <li>✓ Some elements reflect my author's style.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Little or no context or development of writing.</li> <li>✓ Little evidence of point of view or clear character(s) and there is little evidence of reflection on my author's work.</li> </ul>
<b>Narrative Strategies and Elaboration</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Shows characters in action.</li> <li>✓ Uses dialogue to reveal character and advance action.</li> <li>✓ Dramatizes scenes.</li> <li>✓ Manages time through straightforward chronology, flashbacks, episodes &amp; transitions, and/or foreshadowing.</li> <li>✓ Provides character motivation.</li> <li>✓ Uses precise word choice resulting in sensory detail and poetic language.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Relies on a narrow range of strategies to manage setting.</li> <li>✓ Uses some strategies, such as dialogue, with effectiveness.</li> <li>✓ Uses some details to advance the action and describe the character's personality and actions; details may be generic rather than particularized or "shown."</li> <li>✓ Ending may rely on external events rather than on character decision or action.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Relies on straightforward "and then" chronology."</li> <li>✓ Presents main character using stereotypes, lacking in motivation for actions.</li> <li>✓ Uses some dialogue.</li> <li>✓ May have problems with pacing.</li> <li>✓ May list rather than develop details.</li> <li>✓ Conflict may be drawn out, then abruptly resolved without adequate basis.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ May use one or two narrative strategies with minimal or no effectiveness; e.g., may write as an outline without elaboration or dramatization.</li> <li>✓ May introduce but not develop a main character.</li> <li>✓ May have lists of details strung together in a rambling, undirected manner.</li> </ul>
<b>Organization and Style</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Engages the reader.</li> <li>✓ Includes a clear organizational structure such as a series of events linked together, a moment in time, or a problem solution.</li> <li>✓ Uses sentence structure to support meaning and style.</li> <li>✓ Uses vocabulary and syntax that support meaning.</li> <li>✓ Includes a clear sense of closure.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Engages reader by at least two of the following: use of time, location, character introduction or action.</li> <li>✓ Has a clear organization.</li> <li>✓ Sentences are often cumulative rather than complex.</li> <li>✓ Vocabulary is adequate to carry the meaning of the story.</li> <li>✓ Provides sense of closure.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Provides some initiating information to engage reader.</li> <li>✓ May lack effective organization.</li> <li>✓ Sentences are either short or filled with "and then," "and then."</li> <li>✓ Vocabulary is predictable.</li> <li>✓ May not provide a sense of closure.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Enters the piece with no initiating information.</li> <li>✓ May be major gaps in coherence.</li> <li>✓ Writing may start or stop abruptly.</li> <li>✓ May have simple, fragmented or run-on sentences.</li> <li>✓ Language is usually general, without use of details.</li> <li>✓ Ends abruptly.</li> </ul>
