### CREATING A SLIDE PRESENTATION

Timeframe: (3) 43 minute sessions

L.O. Students will learn the basics of Microsoft® PowerPoint in order to create a slide presentation as a culmination of the work they have done on their exploration of African art.

#### TASK:





1) The slide show will have at least 6 slides and as many as needed to incorporate the students' work. Students are familiar with various slide formats in PowerPoint® and may use these formats and others for their presentation.

Students will use the following slide formats and follow the layout below but may include more in order to complete their "African Art" slide presentation.

- Title Slide
- Bulleted List
- 2 Column Text
- Table
- Text and Clip Art
- Title Only

- 2) The slide show will contain a background color.  
3) The slide show may contain clip art.
