

# State/Colony Power Point Project

Your project must have at least six slides. All slides must:

- Have a background you created
- Animations
- Text that is at least size 22 and in a font that is easy to read
- Automatic timings
- Appropriate sounds (no more than one per slide please)

The first slide must include:

- Name of the state/colony in Word Art
- Partners' first and last names
- The date
- At least one graphic

The next two slides are about the colony and must include:

- Name of colony in Word Art
- At least seven facts (from the notes page)
- At least two graphics

The next two slides are about the present day state and must include:

- Name of state in Word Art
- At least seven facts (from the notes page)
- Graphics on each page that must include
  - o The state flag
  - o A map of the state

The last slide is a bibliography/resources page that must include a list of all the places you found information or graphics for you report. Below are examples of how to cite sources.

**Author. Title. [Online] Available <http://address/filename>, Date.**

Savage, Anne. How to Cite a Web Resource. [Online] Available <http://www.tekmom.com/cite/index.html>, May 13, 2002.

<b>Author</b>	Usually at top or bottom of page. Use this format: Last name, First name MI. If no author name can be found, use the editor or the compiler of the information.
<b>Title</b>	Usually at the top of the web page or in the title bar of the browser window.
<b>URL</b>	The web address, starting with <a href="http://">http://</a>
<b>Date</b>	The date on the page or the date you are looking at the page. Use this format: January 1, 2000
