

Continent Project Rubric and Grading Scale

This guide is to be used by the students and the teacher. The students should refer to this rubric before and during the completion of their project. After the project's completion, students should use this to assess their own work. The teacher may then add his/her assessment and comments. Students may want to write a formal assessment of their own work and include a paragraph which addresses what they would do differently and why. There are a total of 100 points possible. Decide at which level you think your work rates and add up the points. A: 100-90, B: 80-89, C: 70-79, D: 60-69, F: 59 and below.
