

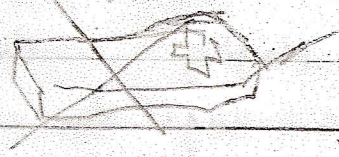
African Burial Grounds

What do I observed?

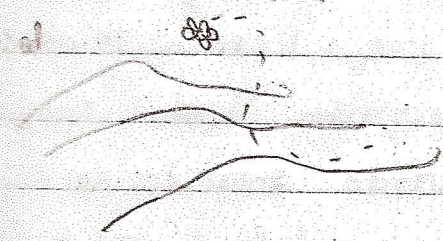
• no gravestones



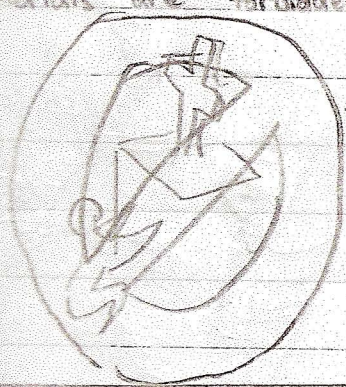
• buried with no coffins
